Multihull Rendevous





Furniture

We have had so many enquiries regarding the furniture packages, I felt we should put something here, again, even if we don't yet have finished pictures yet.

The furniture mouldings come in 3 parts, the 1st is the moulded sections which comprise aft bathroom, sections for the forward ensuite and also the entire saloon (galley, saloon setee, fridge freezer sections and also the nav area).

The second is the structural flat pack and the third is the veneered facia panels which also come in a flat pack. These are all prerouted to shape, so no guess work.

Below: Structural Flat pack



This is the layout plan that the furniture has been developed for.

The nice thing about the layout is it utilizes the maximum head height areas of the saloon for the taller person, and uses the lower side of the cabin as bench and sitting space.



The saloon is one moulding that drops in or can be cut
